

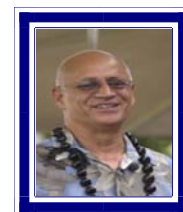

Brothers and Sisters, we are not in competition with other

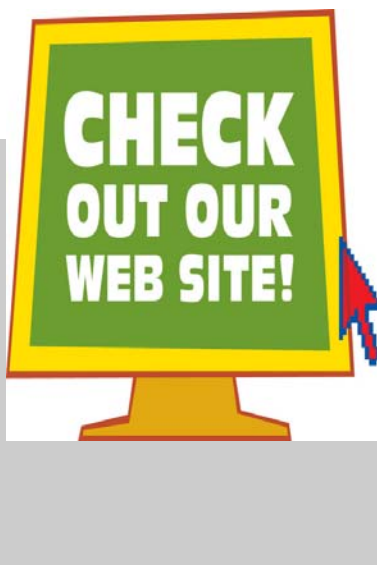

Leilani's Sunday morning at 8am you hear the beautiful voice of Betsy Murray. Staring at the ocean praising and worshipping God, Betsy's voice helps make it come more alive. You can tell when she sings, Betsy is passionate in her talent and loves the Lord with all her heart. She has recorded solo CD's and with other artists including the award winning Wendell Warrington. Basing the ministry on the scripture 1 Cor. 9:22 "To the weak I became weak, to win the weak, I have become all things to all men so that by all possible means I might save some" brings out the meaning

A Verse Frame

Make this special gift for your dad, uncle, grandfather or father-figure. It is nice to be reminded of our heavenly Father's love for us.

What you need:

- Piece of craft foam (8 1/2" x 11", any color)
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Piece of paper (8 1/2" x 11", any color)
- Pencil, crayons or marker
- Foam shapes, stickers (optional)
- Glue
- Hole punch
- Ribbon or yarn



What you do:

1. Use your ruler to measure a rectangle inside the piece of craft foam. Draw the rectangle, and then cut it out. Your foam should now look like a frame.
2. Place the piece of paper under the foam frame, and trace the shape of the frame's window onto the paper.
3. Choose a verse to write inside the rectangle on your paper. (Your frame can go horizontally or vertically.) Suggested verses include 1 Corinthians 8:6, Philippians 4:20 and 1 John 3:1.
4. Turn the frame over (face down), and put glue around the edge. Lay the verse face down on the back of the frame, and let it dry.
5. Decorate the outside of the frame with foam shapes, stickers or drawings.
6. Use your hole punch to punch two holes at the top of the frame. Tie a piece of ribbon or yarn through the holes to hang the frame.

MAKE A "walking snack"

Summer is a great time to take long walks with friends to look at the beauty of God's world. Make an easy "Walking Snack" to take with you on your walk.



Here's what you need:

- apple
- peanut butter
- chocolate chips
- mini-marshmallows
- knife

Here's how to make it:

1. Ask a grownup to help you with this recipe.
2. Hollow out the apple from the top. Remove most of the core, but leave the bottom of the apple uncut.
3. Put some peanut butter into the apple. Fill the hole about halfway.
4. Add some chocolate chips, but leave room for marshmallows.
5. Finish filling the apple with marshmallows.
6. Make another one for a friend.
7. Take the apple snacks along with you when you take a walk with your friend.
